MATS Law School

Introduction to any institution starts with the Chief of the institution who is called either Director, or Dean or Head or Principal. It is well known that any institution is known and recognized by the man who heads it. MATS Law School is headed by Prof. G. P. Tripathi who started his academic career after earning his degrees in Law from Allahabad University and joined the faculty of Law as Assistant Professor there in 1967. He became the senior most Associate Professor in D D University, Gorakhpur, UP and joined as first founding Professor, Head and Dean at Dr. Hari Singh Gaur University, Sagar, MP. He has been in the aforesaid position in one university or the other since then before accepting the responsibility of Director in MATS Law School. Prof. Tripathi is the senior most man in Law discipline in our country and is still active and carrying on with the responsibilities referred above. During his 48 years' career Prof. Tripathi has published more than 20 books on Civil Law and Public Law and around hundred Articles and Research Papers in various reputed Law Journals published in the country and abroad. He has also been Dean in the University of Cross River, Nigeria.

Faculty

As regards the position of faculty, MATS Law School can be considered as one of the topmost Law School in the country. This Law School has the benefits of having trained faculties from reputed National Law Schools of the country. The entire faculty is alumni of non-Traditional Universities and well established Law Universities like NALSAR, CNLU, HNLU, NLIU, Bhopal to name a few. MATS Law School is having the advantage of training from the products of these Universities. All the faculty members are UGC-NET qualified.

Library

Library of MATS Law School is the richest in the state of Chhattisgarh. The library has well equipped and spacious Reading Room with around 2067 text books 1372 Titles 8 Titles of print Journals, Newspapers, Magazines and online databases accessible through WESTLAW, Socio-Legal Studies Association(UK), INDIA LAW. One of the unique features of the library is that the books requested are procured quickly and in case the student is willing to purchase any book, they can purchase it and the money so spent is reimbursed by the university.



Academic Building

MATS law School is housed in its own four storied building which is self-sufficient having air conditioned Lecture Rooms, Reading Rooms, Faculty Rooms, Girl's Common Rooms, Boy's Common Rooms, Moot Court Halls, Library and Seminar Hall. All rooms have internet and Wi-Fi connectivity. Furnishing



Furnishing of Offices, Class Rooms, Discussion Rooms, Moot Court Halls, Conference Hall and Library is of world class. All rooms in the Academic Building are air conditioned and have facilities of computer and high speed internet through Wi-Fi.

Hostel

The University has separate hostels for boys and girls. The Director and faculty are available to the student round the clock for guidance and for



ensuring the security and safety of inmates. The campus boasts of one of the safest campus in the country which ensures the safety and security of the students and is equipped with all the necessary facilities for a comfortable stay and good learning environment.

Recognition by Statutory Regulators

MATS University is established as per Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956 and was established under the Chhattisgarh Act No.29 of 2006 enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Chhattisgarh and notified in the Chhattisgarh Gazette (Extraordinary) dated 3rd November 2006. His Excellency the Governor of the State of Chhattisgarh is Visitor of the University.

All courses are recognized by the Bar Council of India for the next five years.

The University is recognized by the UGC and the PURC and the documents supporting it can be accessed on the university website. The University is also a member of Association of Indian Universities.

Research

The studies in college and university have no basic difference. The difference lies in the research being conducted in a University and the methodology adopted in conducting this research. MATS Law School is fortunate enough to have both, the resources and the methodology. Law school publishes a bi-annual journal known as MATS University Journal with ISSN Number 2250-3889. In this journal, Research Papers from national and international authors are published, once these are approved on peer review.

M. Phil., Ph.D. and LL.D. are specialties of MATS Law Schools which have already produced several LL.Ds, Ph.D.'s including High Court Judges and Directors of National Educational repute. Many High Court Judges and Ph.D. holders are registered in MATS Law School are working for LL.D.

Collaborations

MATS Law School has signed MoU with Chanakya National Law University, Patna for student and faculty exchanges and collaborative research. Another MoU has been signed between MATS Law School and Indo European Education Foundation (IEEF), Warsaw, Poland for the aforesaid purposes. IEEF is also interested in establishing a center of its own in MATS University which is likely to take shape by the end of this month.

European Students Exchange Program for Internship:

MATS Law School has been selected for Internship by European Students which is rare for any University in India. MATS University is going to host these internees for 90 days with effect from last week of June 2015.

Moot Court

Moot Courts are an essential part of the curriculum in MATS and the students are required to participate in a minimum number of six moot



courts in every semester. Students are also encouraged to participate in similar competitions organized by other Law Schools. MATS Law itself organizes one National Moot Court Competition and two Intra Moot Court Competition every year. This year also the Law school is going to host the third edition of Shri Mangilal Pagariya Memorial Moot Court competition in October.

Seminars and Conferences

One Moot Court, one Seminar and five Extension Lectures by the Eminent



Jurists and Scholars are the hallmarks of MATS Law School. MATS Law School encourages its students and faculty to attend and participate in different Seminars, Conferences and Workshops. This year in the month of March MATS Law school organized the 2nd edition of Annual Shri Motilalji Pagariya Memorial Global Seminar on 'Green Law, Environment and the Climate Change' and was a great success with participation from across India and abroad.

Examination

Teaching and examinations are the two criteria for which any university is famed or defamed. The curriculum at MATS Law School is one of the most innovative one and is regularly updated. Examination system is divided into Internal Continuous Assessment of maximum 40 marks and written examination of 60 marks. The internal assessment consists of the activities like Home Assignment (total 6), Class Room Exercises (total 6), Case Studies/Solutions (total six) and Projects, Projects, one in each subject, Research Publications, Conference Papers and attending Moot Courts also carry marks in this process of evaluation. Minimum pass marks in each subject is 50.

Placement

MATS Law School boasts of 100% placements for all the students of the two batches who have passed out. The Alumni of the college are full of praise for the course curriculum. Most of the students have been placed in the pay packages of minimum 4 to 5 lakhs per annum with different Law firms and LPOs. Also many of the students have joined either the Bar or Post Graduate Studies in global Universities wherein degree of MATS Law School is highly acclaimed.
