12. Generally to take all such measures with the approval of the Council as are likely to accelerate the process of modernization in Chhattisgarh through the use of Science and Technology.

WHEREAS, both School of Biological and Chemical Sciences, MATS University, Raipur and A2 Milk Research Corporation Raipur, now recognizing the importance of research and development in the areas of Biological and Chemical Sciences specially in the field of Biotechnology, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Bioscience and Chemistry also. Appreciating the need for creation of large reservoir of highly qualified manpower in all fields related to Biotechnology, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Bioscience and Chemistry, desiring to club their efforts by pooling their expertise and resources, INTEND to form a nucleus for promoting excellent quality manpower in the fields of Biotechnology, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Bioscience and Chemistry for the Research Programme.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises made herein, the receipt and sufficiency of which both School of Biological and Chemical Sciences, MATS University, Raipur and A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur hereby acknowledge, School of Biological and Chemical Sciences, MATS University, Raipur and A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur agree to sign a memorandum of understanding (MOU).

## **ARTICLE-I:**

### ***Scope of the MOU***

1. Nothing in this MOU shall be given effect to or bind the signatories contrary to or beyond the provisions of CG act no 29 of 2006, or the statutes and ordinances framed there in by or for MATS University or rules, regulations or directions of state government, PURC UGC or any other regulatory body having authority in MATS University. This MOU details the modalities and general conditions regarding collaboration between School of Biological and Chemical Sciences, MATS University, Raipur and A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur for enhancing, within the country, the availability of highly qualified manpower in the fields of Biotechnology, Microbiology, Biochemistry, Bioscience and Chemistry for the Research Programme without any prejudice to prevailing rules and regulations in School of Biological and Chemical Sciences, MATS University, Raipur and A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur without any disregard to any mechanism evolved and approved by the competent authorities under Govt. of India in so far as such mechanism applies to MATS University and A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur. The areas of cooperation can be extended through mutual consent.

## **ARTICLE-II:**

### ***Scope and Terms of Interactions***

School of Biological and Chemical Sciences, MATS University and A2 Milk Research Corporation shall encourage interactions between the Scientists, Research fellows, faculty members and students of both the organizations through the following arrangements:

- 2.1 Exchange of personnel through deputation as per the rules of the respective institute, for limited periods as mutually agreed upon;
- 2.2 Organization of joint conferences, workshops and seminars.
- 2.3 Practical training and Research Work of MATS University students, Research Scholars at A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur;
- 2.4 Joint guidance of student projects/thesis in Biological and Chemical Sciences and other areas of national interest at MATS University by A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur on mutually agreeable terms.
- 2.5 A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur may depute its eligible personnel as per the norms of concerned regulatory bodies as visiting faculty at MATS University to teach any of the regular Course or specialized topics.
- 2.6 A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur would accommodate students of School of Biological and Chemical Sciences, MATS University, Raipur in such a number that A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur deems convenient to it for the purpose of imparting Industrial training.



- 2.7 A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur personnel, as well as research scholars, may also be allowed to enrol them for pursuing Ph.D., M.Phil, & PG Programmes at School of Biological and Chemical Sciences, MATS University, subject to availability of seats, research facilities and subject to their fulfilling eligibility criteria and all other academic regulations of MATS University. Further, A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur may request to teach a Course or Courses which it deems fit to enhance quality and performance of its employees for their development of the career. Such Courses may be run at any mutually convenient premises.
- 2.8 A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur may seek assistance/guidance of School of Biological and Chemical Sciences, MATS University faculty member/s in product/process modification, modernization, trouble shooting, etc.
- 2.9 A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur would allow the industrial visits of students for half/full day to provide them with an exposure to various equipment, instrument, etc.
- 2.10 A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur may showcase its research activities at the seminar / workshop / conference, etc. at MATS University.
- 2.11 Post -graduate student will be allotted a Research supervisor from MATS University faculty members. A Research Scientist / Guide at A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur may be appointed as a Co-research guide as per the rules of the respective institute for a student Registered for Ph.D / M.Phil, and PG Programmes (Regular or Research) degree at MATS University. The student shall be encouraged to take up the project such that A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur desirably benefits from its outcome and is beneficial for the career growth of the concerned student.
- 2.12 The students will carry out part of their Ph.D. research work or projects of other programmes at MATS University and A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur depending on the nature of the work as per rules of the respective institute depending on facilities and requirements.
- 2.13 There will be no restriction on the contents of the thesis and on publication of results of the thesis, subject to the condition that no Intellectual Property Rights can be secured for any part of the work which will be decided with mutual consent.
- 2.14 Both School of Biological and Chemical Sciences, MATS University, Raipur and A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur will be free to independently carry out follow-up research on the thesis work conducted under this scheme.

### **ARTICLE-III:**

#### ***The Agreement***

- 3.1 At School of Biological and Chemical Sciences, MATS University, this MOU will be administered by **Head, School of Biological and Chemical Sciences, Raipur**. At A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur this MOU will be administered by **The Managing Director, A2 Milk Research Corporation, Raipur**.
- 3.2 This MOU may also involve parties by mutual consent, which may be added later by written addendum to this MOU.

3.3 The parties may enter into specific written agreements under authority of this MOU to clarify and define the nature, extent and terms of operation for the proposed collaborations, including intellectual property ownership and funding issues.

#### **ARTICLE-IV:**

##### **General Terms**

- 4.1 This MOU is not intended to, and does not create any right, benefit, or trust responsibility, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or equity, by either party, its officers, employees, or agents against the other party, its officers, employees, or agents.
- 4.2 Nothing in this MOU obligates either party to commit or transfer any funds, assets, or other resources in support of projects or activities between the parties unless expressly stated in this agreement.
- 4.3 This MOU does not involve any financial commitment or expenditure on part of signatories and/or beneficiaries (Researchers/Students).
- 4.4 The terms of this MOU can be amended / MOU can be rescinded by either of the two signatories on 3 months prior notice to the other party of its intention to do so.

### Introduction

The MATS University of Raipur and Agrasen Mahavidyalaya, Raipur believing the extension and strengthening of scientific exchange and co-operation to be mutual value to their universities and to the development of understanding between our people, hereby record their intentions to promote educational exchange between their Institutions through the following activities.

## 1. PRACTICAL EXCHANGE PROGRAM

### 1.1 Exchange of students

MATS will provide to Agrasen Mahavidyalaya, Raipur with access to its practicum program for students who wish to come to MATS to obtain research experiences or professional practice in the field of Commerce. The Practicum Exchange Program is for limited period twelve months and may be a formal requirement for the award of a degree at the student's home Institution.

1.2 Both Institutions agree that the exchange program for training should follow the educational system and regulations of the counterpart university. Students from each college or faculty who apply for degree or non-degree program shall submit their applications to other college or faculty through its own university.

## 2. COOPERATIVE RESEARCH

2.1 Co-operative research is to be encouraged as individual scholars or departments establish contact and develop mutual interests in niche areas in commerce. The cost intellectual property rights and other conditions of such agreements will be negotiated on case to case basis.

### 3. TERMS OF CO-OPERATION

3.1 The terms of co-operation for each specific activity implemented under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity.

3.2 Any such agreement entered into, as outlined above, will form an Appendix to this.

### 4. CO-ORDINATION OF THE EXCHANGE

4.1 Each Institution shall designate a Liaison Officer to develop and co-ordinate the specific activities agreed upon.

4.2 Through these offices, either of the parties may indicate may initiate proposals for activities and specific details of any such activities will be set forth in a letter of agreement.

### 5. RENEWAL, TREATMENT AND AMENDMENT

5.1 This Memorandum of Understanding becomes effective on the signature by both parties. It may be amended by agreement of the parties. It is renewed every Five years without change on that date unless one party gives notice six months in advance.

5.2 For this purpose, the responsible parties will be the Registrar of MATS University, Raipur and the Principal, Agrasen Mahavidyalaya, Raipur.

### 6. CONFLICT RESOLUTION

6.1 Any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of or in relation to this MoU, including the validity, invalidity, breach of termination thereof, shall be settled by both Institutions amicably by a mutual agreement between the two representatives of the institutes. Conflicts that can not be resolved amicably shall be settled by arbitration.

## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

### **PREAMBLE**

The MATS Law School (hereinafter referred as MLS), MATS University, Raipur C.G. is a department of MATS University, recognized under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956 and was established under the Chhattisgarh Private Universities (Establishment & Maintenance) Act of 2005 as amended by C. G. Act No. 29 of 2006 enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Chhattisgarh and notified in the Chhattisgarh Gazette (Extraordinary) dated 3rd November 2006. At MATS Law School, Law teaching is interwoven with related contemporary issues, including international and comparative law perspectives. The college offers 5 years integrated law (Hons.) degree courses in B.B.A. LL.B, B.A. LL.B. and B. Tech LL.B., B.Sc. LL.B. and 3 years professional law degree course in LL.B. Besides the college also offers 2 years Masters degree LL.M. (semester and annual pattern and distance mode). It also offers one year (3 trimester) Masters degree in Counter Terrorism Studies and Law, Public Accountability Laws, Aviation and Aviation Management Laws, Air and Space laws, International Investment Law and International Business Law, M. Phil, Ph. D. in Law and post-doctoral LL.D.

The Chanakya National Law University (hereinafter referred as CNLU) was established under the Bihar Act No. of 2006. The University was included under Section 2(f) of the UGC Act, 1956. with its headquarters at Patna. It is a People's University" with an aspiration to provide quality legal education totally socially relevant and accessible to everyone.

Whereas, MATS Law School desires to establish academic collaboration with Institutions of excellence in Law in the country and CNLU is one among such recognized institutions and seeks to promote the Institutional collaborations through this Memorandum of Understanding.



## **SCOPE OF AGREEMENT**

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed between the MLS as First Party and CNLU as Second Party for the purpose of academic collaboration that will encompass exchange of students and members of faculty between the two parties as well as other academic activities, research and publication. In addition to this, active efforts will be made to develop joint training and research programmes that will be pursued in a collaborative spirit. Some of the collaborative areas include the following:

### **I. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF COOPERATION:**

1. MLS and CNLU shall collaborate in mutually agreeable academic events, teaching, training and research, wherever feasible. Such collaboration will be based on mutually agreeable terms and conditions specifically agreed for each of the collaborative efforts;
2. MLS and CNLU shall offer full time regular as well as optional courses to the undergraduate and post-graduate courses offered at these institutions from time to time on mutually agreeable terms and conditions;
3. The Ph.D. and LL.D. candidates in interdisciplinary areas of research involving law from the Chanakya National Law University shall work under the supervision of the faculty members of MLS or If agreed, jointly supervised by the faculty members from the two parties;
4. Faculty members from each of these universities shall be invited for important seminars, conferences and for teaching at doctoral level. The financial implications shall be worked out on a case to case basis;
5. Those modalities for a similar exchange of researchers and faculty members will be laid down through mutual discussion that should be made operational for a period of five years;
6. Ph.D. and LL.D. Scholars of both the Universities are welcome to make use of the library resources of each other and to have academic interaction with the faculty;
7. Research Scholars and Teaching Faculty of both MLS and CNLU will explore possibility of taking up collaborative research work and also apply for funding from national and international agencies, governments and other funding agencies;
8. Any financial implication emerging out of such collaborations (other than the fees of the students etc.) shall be worked out and decisions will be taken with mutual agreement.

### **II. AREAS OF COOPERATION**

This Memorandum expresses a mutual desire by MLS and CNLU co-operates in building intellectual and research capacity and scholarship. Additional areas of co-operation may be

added by written consent of the two the parties. Both parties will act in good faith to ensure that the objectives in this Memorandum are realized.

### III. TERMS OF AGREEMENT

Progress in realizing the terms and conditions referred to herein will be reviewed periodically as mutually agreed and the memorandum may be amended at any time by mutual consent and in writing. Both parties reserve the right to terminate this memorandum by either party by giving six months written notice to the other. The implementation and/or continuance of programmes or projects established pursuant to this memorandum prior to the effective date of termination shall not be affected by the termination of this Memorandum.

### IV. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND CONFIDENTIALITY

1. In respect of each project and programme of co-operation, the parties shall negotiate and mutually agree in writing on their respective rights to intellectual property and commercial exploitation of the same (including without limitation, trademarks and service marks, copyrights, patents, designs and confidential information pertaining thereto).

2. Neither party shall, at any time disclose to any third party any confidential information of the other party which is acquired in the course of activities under this Memorandum, a collaborative project or a programme, without the prior consent of the other party in writing.

The confidentiality obligations herein will not apply to information in the public domain; information in the possession of the receiving party prior to the disclosure of the information; information which is independently developed by the receiving party; information required to be released by law; and information which is rightfully received by the receiving party from third parties without any breach of confidentiality obligations.

### V. NON-BINDING NATURE OF MEMORANDUM

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any contract, partnership, agency or other legal relationship between the parties. This Memorandum is only a non-binding statement of intent to foster and mutually beneficial collaboration.

### VI. TERMINATION


1. This memorandum shall come into force immediately upon its signature by the parties.

2. The validity of this Memorandum of Understanding is initially for a period of five years from the date of its execution and the same can be further extended on mutual agreement.


3. This Memorandum of Understanding can be terminated by either of the parties by giving advance notice of six months and without jeopardizing the coursework or registration of any of the students of either institution.

## Memorandum of Understanding

## COMMITMENT BY Disha Art Shala For COE Establishment.

- a. Timing of Classes : From 9.00 am to 5.00 pm on weekdays and 6-7 Hrs/day on Saturday or Sunday or Holidays (as per requirement)
- b. To conduct individual project evaluation and maintain the records.
- c. To ensure the completion of the Final Project report.
- d. Provide Certificates to students after completion of training & will also provide Course Material to students free of cost during training, if any.
- e. To maintain Central Repository of Final Project Reports.
- f. Once the student enrolled with Disha Art Shala with registration fee, it will not be refunded, until & unless it is discussed between both the parties, Disha Art Shala and MATS University, and the case are found genuine.

- j. Permission for seminar in the classes with an Intimation of 2 days before during non-academic periods.
- k. Special approval can be sought, if Duty Leaves are required.

### Joint Responsibilities

The Host College/University will collaborate with the Company on the career and college readiness curriculum necessary for the completion of the planned marketing work.

The Host College/University and the Company agree to prohibit students, members, or staff from publishing any materials as a direct result of activities in different locations unless such publication is approved for release, in writing, by the Host College/University and the Company and such approval is not to be withheld unreasonably.

The company must train the representatives from the Host on how to handle the various marketing related issues accordingly and from time to time in case of any change in the marketing plan and present the marketing outline to the host so as to keep them informed about the activities taking place from time to time.

Both the Company and the Host College/University shall provide distinct wrap-around services to ensure the success of each marketing campaign. Such wrap-around services shall include:

Use of names, logos, or other representations of either entity on such materials is subject to approval by authorized administrative authorities of the Company or the Host College/University, as applicable.

## Termination

This MOU agreement will be declared to be breached if any of the above mentioned conditions are not fulfilled or met. Any breach in this agreement will adversely affect the outcome of the results expected during the marketing for the college.

## Amendments

This Memorandum of Understanding may only be modified by an amendment executed by both parties from time to time.



This Recycling Agreement ("Agreement") is made on 09-Dec-2016 by and between

**MATS UNIVERSITY**, having its registered office at AARANG – KHARORA HIGHWAY, AARANG, RAIPUR, CHHATTISGARH 493441, India which expression shall unless repugnant to the context include its legal representatives, administrators, executors, nominees, successors and assigns of the first part.

AND

**NAMO EWASTE MANAGEMENT LTD.** having office at 14/1 Milestone Mathura Road Faridabad -121003 which expression shall unless repugnant to the context include its legal representatives, administrators, executors, nominees, successors and assigns of the second part.

Whereas **MATS University** has IT, and all electrical, electronic products/ service related hardware material (the "Material" as hereinafter defined) that it may from time to time wish to recycle, and **NEML** desires to execute a complete recycling program on behalf of **MATS University** to process the Material.

THEREFORE, **MATS University** shall provide, and **NEML** shall recycle the Material in accordance with the following terms of this Agreement:

1. **Material**- Material is hereinafter defined as all forms of electronics equipments, IT equipments like Desktops, Monitor, Laptop, Servers, Modems and converters, Multiplexes, Switches XDSLs, ADSL, Wireless radio, DCME, Backhaul Optimisation,

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Optical, CPE telecommunications equipments, including but not limited to laptops, desktops, servers, network personal equipments, monitors, telephony, printers, faxes, copiers, data assistants process control equipment, server towers, server racks, scanners, batteries, server battery backups, uninterruptible power supplies, electronic storage media and all accessories and peripherals for above mentioned equipments including toners which **MATS University** may want to recycle. Material specifically excludes equipments containing radioactive materials, free flowing liquids, chlorofluorocarbons, polychlorinated biphenyls, or other "Hazardous Wastes".

2. **Services**- NEML shall provide following services to **MATS University**:

- (i) Collection, transportation and destruction of Material from various **MATS University** locations.
- (ii) **MATS University** will notify **NEML** for pick up as per the accumulation of WEEE with different locations pan India. Collection of the Material, within 10 working days or case to case from date of notice by authorised person of **MATS University** from it's premises.
- (iii) **NEML** shall destruct the entire quantity of Material within 15 working days of receipt of Material. **MATS University's** representative may also witness the destruction at **NEML's** facility or request written confirmation by Certificate of destruction form **NEML**.

3. **Payment** -**NEML** shall bear all handling costs for the items collected from **MATS University** in full and all costs associated with the provision of the Services rendered.

Commercials: Free of Cost (FOC) as **NEML** shall bear all the transportation and labour cost involved in despatching material from our collection centre in Raipur C.G. to the recycling plant in Faridabad, Haryana.

4. **NEML Representation and Warranties** –

- 4.1 In the performance of all Services to be provided hereunder, **NEML** agrees to comply with all applicable permits, all central, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances and all duly constituted authorities. Upon request of **MATS University**, **NEML** shall furnish copies thereof to **MATS University**.
- 4.2 **NEML** will be responsible for the statutory compliances including environmental compliances pertaining to the recycling activities and Services and **MATS University** will not in any way be responsible for the same once the scrap material is handed over by **MATS University** to **NEML**.
- 4.3 **NEML** has obtained all necessary permits, licenses and other central, state or local authorizations required to perform the Services and upon request of **MATS University**, **NEML** shall furnish copies thereof to **MATS University**.
- 4.4 **NEML** shall keep and retain adequate books and records and other documentation consistent with and for the periods required by applicable regulatory requirements and guidelines pertaining to performance of the Services required by this Agreement. Said records, books and documentation relevant to

  
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**MATS University** shall be available for inspection by **MATS University** upon reasonable advance notice.

- 4.5 **NEML** shall not resell the Material in the original form which has been collected from **MATS University** except after totally destroying the Material for purpose of recycling.
- 4.6 **NEML** agrees and undertakes to indemnify **MATS University** for any liability, claims including third party claims, legal actions against **MATS University**, arising out of any negligent action or wilful misconduct by **NEML**.
- 4.7 **NEML** shall comply at their own expense with all laws, ordinances and /or directives of the country in which it conducts business as they relate to the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, Child labour laws, data privacy laws, criminal reporting laws, environmental, health and safety laws or any similar laws in performance of its obligations under this Agreement.

**NEML** will be fully responsible for the personnel deployed by it for providing the Services to **MATS University**.

- 4.8 As an integral part of this Agreement, **NEML** hereby represents that they or any of their officials or representatives shall not give or promise to give any money or gift to any employee / official of **MATS University** to influence its decisions regarding this Agreement, nor shall they exert or utilize any unlawful influence to solicit or secure this Agreement through a promise to pay a commission, percentage, brokerage or contingent fee. Further, **NEML** warrants that they shall not give or promise any such money or gift, or exert or utilize such unlawful influence during the term of this Agreement or to secure or solicit any extension thereof. It is agreed that breach of this representation and warranty clause by **NEML** shall be sufficient grounds for **MATS University** to immediately terminate this Agreement. Breach of this clause shall also be sufficient ground for **MATS University** to file legal actions as may be necessary. Breach of this clause shall also be sufficient ground for **MATS University** to stop/withdraw all instructions for Services and demand payment for Services rendered till date and also file legal actions as may be necessary. Further, in the event it is found that **NEML** or its employees have worked in liaison with any of **MATS University's** employees with the intention to defraud **MATS University**, this Agreement may be terminated by **MATS University**. **NEML** shall immediately inform **MATS University** of any incident whereby any of **MATS University's** employee/s approaches **NEML** and/ or its employees with the intention of colluding to commit any acts to defraud **MATS University**, failing which **NEML** will be deemed to be a party to such fraud and liable for any loss or damage caused to **MATS University** by the commission of such acts.
- 4.9 **NEML** shall ensure that the Material is transported safely and there is no leakage during transit.
- 4.10 **NEML** confirms and warrants that the Material so collected by it under this Agreement shall not be misused by it directly or indirectly or dealt with in any

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- other manner other than as expressly stated in this Agreement, and agrees to indemnify **MATS University** in case such representation of **NEML** is false.
- 4.11 **NEML** shall ensure that all government approvals, statutory compliances and QEHS certifications are in place

#### **4A BUSINESS CONTINUITY MANAGEMENT PLAN**

- a) **NEML** shall ensure that at all times it has in place and is able to implement a business continuity and disaster recovery plan which will ensure the continued performance and operational resilience of the Services/ deliverables provided by the **NEML**.
- b) **NEML** shall develop, update and test the business continuity plan on a regular basis and, in any event, not less than once in every 12 month period, in accordance with good industry practice.
- c) **NEML** shall be open to the audit of its business continuity arrangements by **MATS University** as and when required by **MATS University**

#### **5 MATS University Representations and Warranties**

- 5.1 **MATS University** has free and unencumbered title to all Material delivered to **NEML** pursuant to this Agreement.
  - 5.2 **MATS University** shall not knowingly ship Hazardous Wastes to **NEML** pursuant to this Agreement. In the event Hazardous Wastes are identified upon receipt at **NEML** or during subsequent processing, such substances will be quarantined in manner sufficient to reasonably protect human health and real and personal property. **NEML** will notify **MATS University** of identified substances and assist **MATS University** in the resolution and proper disposition of the substances, including lawful packaging, labelling and disposal. **MATS University** will be solely responsible for all related costs.
  - 5.3 **MATS University** shall issue all proper despatch documents (invoices, gare pass, declarations, sales tax forms etc), where applicable, and Form 13 as per the hazardous waste manifest for transportation along with the Material authorisation and ownership transfer letter for transport.
- 6 **Term** - This agreement shall be in force for one years from the date of last signature of this Agreement ("09-Dec-2016") unless and until terminated in a manner set forth in paragraph 8.2 below or as provided for elsewhere in the Agreement. This Agreement may however be terminated by **MATS University** at any time during the term, without giving any advance notice to **NEML**, in case **NEML** fails to comply with its obligations under this Agreement.
- 7 **Independent Contractor** - In furnishing Services pursuant to this Agreement, **NEML** will at all times be acting as an independent contractor and this Agreement will not be

**8 Miscellaneous –**



- 8.5 This Agreement constitutes and fully expresses the entire and only agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter thereof; all prior and collateral understandings, agreements and promises with respect thereto are considered merged herein. This Agreement may not be modified, waived, or extended unless mutually agreed to in writing, and it may not be terminated except as provided above. A waiver by either party of any terms and conditions of this Agreement in one or more instances will not constitute a permanent waiver of such terms and conditions unless so stated in writing.
- 8.6 The agreement will be applicable for all three e-waste facilities fully operational throughout India under the trading name of **NEML**.

### Introduction

The MATS University of Raipur and Gurukul Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Raipur believing the extension and strengthening of scientific exchange and co-operation to be mutual value to their universities and to the development of understanding between our people, hereby record their intentions to promote educational exchange between their Institutions through the following activities.

## 1. PRACTICAL EXCHANGE PROGRAM

### 1.1 Exchange of students

MATS will provide Gurukul Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Raipur with access to its practicum program for students who wish to come to MATS to obtain research experiences or professional practice in the field of Commerce. The Practicum Exchange Program is for limited period twelve-months and may be a formal requirement for the award of a degree at the student's home Institution.

1.2 Both Institutions agree that the exchange program for training should follow the educational system and regulations of the counterpart university. Students from each college or faculty who apply for degree or non-degree program shall submit their applications to other college or faculty through its own university.

## 2. COOPERATIVE RESEARCH

2.1 Co-operative research is to be encouraged as individual scholars or departments establish contact and develop mutual interests in niche areas in commerce. The cost intellectual property rights and other conditions of such agreements will be negotiated on case to case basis.



### 3. TERMS OF CO-OPERATION

- 3.1 The terms of co-operation for each specific activity implemented under this Memorandum of Understanding shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of that activity.
- 3.2 Any such agreement entered into, as outlined above, will form an Appendix to this.

### 4. CO-ORDINATION OF THE EXCHANGE

- 4.1 Each Institution shall designate a Liaison Officer to develop and co-ordinate the specific activities agreed upon.
- 4.2 Through these offices, either of the parties may indicate may initiate proposals for activities and specific details of any such activities will be set forth in a letter of agreement.

### 5. RENEWAL, TREATMENT AND AMENDMENT

- 5.1 This Memorandum of Understanding becomes effective on the signature by both parties. It may be amended by agreement of the parties. It is renewed every Five years without change on that date unless one party gives notice six months in advance.
- 5.2 For this purpose, the responsible parties will be the Registrar of MATS University, Raipur and the Principal Gurukul Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Raipur.

### 6. CONFLICT RESOLUTION

- 6.1 Any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of or in relation to this MoU, including the validity, invalidity, breach of termination thereof, shall be settled by both Institutions amicably by a mutual agreement between the two representatives of the institutes. Conflicts that can not be resolved amicably shall be settled by arbitration.

The implementation of this understanding is contingent upon full satisfaction of the requirements and expectations of the appropriate faculty governance; upon the approval of the proposal by the executive officers/authorities of both institutions, and where appropriate by the institution's Board of Trustees.

Any suggestions for changes in the substance or scope of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) should be presented, in writing, by the signatories making the proposal at least 6 (six) months prior to the end of the academic year in progress.

### Legal and Financial Status of this Memorandum of Understanding

1. Neither this Memorandum nor any following Memorandum of Understanding is a contract to create financial obligation to the partner university. This Memorandum and its subsequent Memorandum of Understandings are designed solely to facilitate the development of mutually beneficial academic and research collaborative initiatives.
2. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding or any Memorandum of Understanding concluded in pursuance thereof, no agency is created between the parties.
3. Parties using their existing resources shall share all costs associated with the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding.
4. Partner University, and Foundation may refer to this program in their catalogs and other appropriate publications materials.
5. This Memorandum of Understanding is to be in effect with the 2014-15 academic year and will be valid for duration of five (5) years. In case of no notification of annulment/ dissolve, MOU will be continued automatically for the unlimited period of time.
6. This MOU doesn't cover any membership fee.
7. To access full support from Foundation, Partner University must sign separate IEEF's Program Membership Form, which suppose to be the matter of renewals of every year before beginning of new academic year.

### Academic Co-operation

**Joint Research Studies, Conferences and Projects:** To the end of enhancing global competitiveness and of accelerating the knowledge-based economy, the two partners agree to cooperate in the organization of timely joint forums, conferences, seminars, research studies, workshops, joint projects, joint publications, training programs for students, scholars and corporates etc., in the broad area of economic development. These symposia will aim to bring together selected individuals and scholars representing the industrial, commercial, government and academic scholars, *inter alias*, to the end of identifying and promoting initiatives leading to improved socio-economic well being of our changing global society and to develop students and scholars experiences.

#### Student Exchanges

- 1). Foundation will provide list of recommended European Universities, where Exchange programs can take place in the interest of both the university's and faculties.
- 2). Each institution will be responsible to verify the necessary skills and qualifications/abilities of students to join exchange programs. For the enrollment- students must contact the *official's of exchange program advisors* at each institution and follow the established application guidelines, policies, and procedures required for all participants. The home institution will verify that the selected students meet the criteria for study abroad program. Students will complete all application's procedure at the study abroad institution through foundation only. Partner Universities are obliged to follow all guidelines given by Foundation.
- 3). It has been agreed that 20 exchange students for per academic calendar year may be sent from either Institution through Foundation, unless other arrangements are made with the appropriate administrators or university officers in India or in Europe (EU).
- 4). No tuition fees will be exchanged between institutions.
- 5). All housing costs, book expenses, and other costs will be paid out of pocket by students at the site where they study.
- 6). Students participating in this program will remain registered at their own institution during their period of attendance in the study abroad program. During this time students will also have all the rights and privileges of regular students at their home institution and will be subject to the home institution's regulations and policies. Students will also have the rights and privileges of regular students at the partner institution and will be subject to the regulations and policies of the partner institution.
- 7). An exchange may take place for minimum 15 days to maximum 180 days during any academic year.
- 8). Both partners will make proposal and settle transcripts for each student participating under



Exchange program. Each partner university will sign separate MOU with Indian University for this proposed program through Indo-European Education Foundation.

#### **Faculty Exchange**

Both institutions agree on the following forms of cooperation:

- 1). Foundation will provide selective experts/scholars from Indian universities/ institutes/ organizations for short visit to the partner university for delivering short lecture for minimum 2 days to maximum 90 days, where proposed topic/syllabus must be covered either under specific programs or external programs running by the partner university.
- 2). Mutual invitations for up to 3 months duration for any appropriate faculty member- to teach, to present lectures, to conduct seminars, symposiums, and conferences, and to share experiences with colleagues at the partner institution.
- 3). Exchange of information and scholarships in the field of interest to both the partners for the period of research or, training in designated fields of cooperation.
- 4). Compensation may be provided for teaching a class as appropriate based on the host university's regulations.

#### **Research Collaboration**

- 1). Both institutions will collaborate inter se in conducting research and its publication.
- 2). The details of collaboration would be worked out through instrument of implementation.
- 3). The fact of MoU shall be shown on the website of the two organizations for public view.
- 4). The MATS Law School shall get right to share research projects with all organizations in touch with Indo-European Education Foundation.
- 5). Both the organizations agree to begin with recognition of degrees and diploma awarded to students in and by both organizations.
- 6). To begin with, MATS Law School has proposed Post Graduate Diploma in Medical Jurisprudence, Toxicology and Legal Medicines.
- 7). The proposal is accepted to by the 'Foundation' and the implementation details shall be worked out by reciprocal deliberations.
- 8). In future the organizations shall show and conduct seminars/workshops/conferences, wherein the fact of the MoU shall be displayed for public view.

### **Non-academic Cooperation<sup>1</sup>**

#### **Direct Students Admission to the Partner University (DSAPU)**

- 1). To bring more effectiveness for long-term cooperation and faculty exchange program; Foundation is obliged to implement CET-India test for all Indian students seeking higher education abroad European union. CET-India test is going to be for different degree programs- Bachelor, Master, and PhDs from Indian regions for European Partner Universities. Also Partner University's CET should be considered as eligible for selection process.
- 2). Under DSAPU program Indian Partner University/Students are obliged to pay full tuition fee to the host Partner university.
- 3). Partner University will receive maximum 20 students for each faculties/departments for every semester through direct admission under CET-India umbrella launched by Foundation (IEEF).

#### **Administrative Collaborations with Polish (EU) Universities**

- 1). Foundation will provide list of Polish (EU) universities to establish academic collaborations between them and Partner University.
- 2). Provide full support to enter in new cooperation with Indian Partner University's towards implementations of dual certificate/degree programs with Partner university.
- 3). Provide academic staff to teach at regular to Partner University under running programs for foreign students.
- 4). Commenting to the media about various issues related to India and Poland/EU (interviews, articles).
- 5). Organizing international conferences to bringing together scholars and businesses from India to Poland and Poland to India; or to support Partner University to achieve their interest in Indian market.

### **Corporate/ MNCs Co-operation**

This program is to establish a new relationship between academia and corporates. Under Corporate Program Partner University will be able to access- internships and campus jobs for their students, scholarships supported by MNCs, and training programs for students and scholars.

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<sup>1</sup> To access all nonacademic cooperation IEEF's Program membership is required.



## **Student's Visit to EU under Internship Programs**

- 1). Both- Partner University and Foundation has been agreed that every academic year maximum 30 students can continue their internship programs under guide line of Foundation (IEEF) to well known Indian/ Polish /Global Companies in India or in Poland. Internship will take place during academic breaks/holidays- either in winter or summer breaks- as preferred by Institutions.
- 2). Internship programs can be fully sponsored by the Companies or Partner University or, it can be self funded by participants.
- 3). Under this program students will be able to continue their internships with well known Indian/ Polish companies in the interest of his/her study areas e.g. energy, environment, IT, diplomats, management, outsourcing, Law etc.
- 4). This program can be organize for minimum 15days to maximum 90days, where students suppose to receive corporate experiences in different academic and cultural environment, which will be helpful for them to become future potential employees for the same company.
- 5). Bring MNCs to the Partner University for Placements, where students directly can be interviewed by the company representative's and get selected for his/her future jobs. Campus selections can take place only for the final year students studying at Partner University.

### **§6.**

#### **Term of Memorandum of Understanding Execution**

Memorandum of Understanding shall come into force on the day of its signature and is valid till the end of implementation of the Project.

### **§7.**

#### **Termination of Memorandum of Understanding**

Either institution may terminate this Memorandum at any time. In so doing, the duty authorized representative of the institution initiating such action shall give written notice to the other party at least six (6) months prior to the end of the academic year then in progress, unless the parties mutually agree upon an earlier termination date.

### **§8.**

#### **Final Provisions**

This Memorandum of Understanding was drawn up in four identical copies in English language, one for each of the Parties.

## **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING**

The National Law School of India University (NLSIU) University, Bangalore, established under the National Law School of India Act (Karnataka Act 22 of 1986) in 1987 with the Chief Justice of India as its Chancellor, is the first and the only law university fully supported by the Bar Council of India and the Bench. One of the main objectives of NLSIU is to 'bring legal education on par with other professional courses like medicine and engineering, where a student fresh out of high-school can make an immediate career choice'. The NLSIU has been conducting a strong B.A, LL.B (Hons.), LL.M, M.Phil., Ph.D and LL.D programs in Law. The NLSIU has made strides in teaching the law courses with both interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary dimensions and facilitating research and publication on those lines since its establishment.

MATS University was established in 2006 by the Government of Chhattisgarh under the C.G. State Act 29 of 2006 with its headquarters at Raipur.

**Whereas,** MATS University, desires to establish academic collaboration with Institutions of excellence in Law in the country and NLSIU is one among such recognized institutions and seeks to promote the institutional collaborations through this Memorandum of Understanding.



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## **SCOPE OF AGREEMENT**

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed between the National Law School of India University (NLSIU) as First Party and MATS University Raipur, Chhattisgarh as Second Party for the purpose of Academic Collaboration that will encompass exchange of students and members of faculty between the two parties as well as other academic activities, research and publication. In addition to this active efforts will be made to develop joint training and research programmes that will be pursued in a collaborative spirit. Some of the collaborative areas include the following:

### **I. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF COOPERATION:**

1. NLSIU and MATS University shall collaborate in mutually agreeable academic events, teaching, training and research, wherever feasible. Such collaboration will be based on mutually agreeable terms and conditions specifically agreed for each of the collaborative efforts;
2. NLSIU and MATS University shall offer full time regular as well as optional courses to the under-graduate and post-graduate courses offered at these institutions from time to time on mutually agreeable terms and conditions;
3. The Ph.D. candidates in interdisciplinary areas of research involving law from the MATS University shall work under the supervision of the faculty members of NLSIU or if agreed, jointly supervised by the faculty members from the two parties;
4. Faculty members from each of these universities shall be invited for important seminars, conferences and for teaching at doctoral level. The financial implications shall be worked out on a case to case basis;





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5. Those modalities for a similar exchange of researchers and faculty members will be laid down through mutual discussion that should be made operational for a period of five years;
6. Ph.D. Scholars of both the Universities are welcome to make use of the library resources of each other and to have academic interaction with the faculty;
7. Research Scholars and Teaching Faculty of both NLSIU and MATS University will explore possibility of taking up collaborative research work and also apply for funding from national and international agencies, governments and other funding agencies;
8. Any financial implication emerging out of such collaborations (other than the fees of the students etc.) shall be worked out and decisions will be taken with mutual agreement.

## **II. AREAS OF COOPERATION:**

This Memorandum expresses a mutual desire by NLSIU and MATS University cooperates in building intellectual and research capacity and scholarship. Additional areas of co-operation may be added by written consent of the two the parties. Both parties will act in good faith to ensure that the objectives in this Memorandum are realized.

## **III. TERMS OF AGREEMENT**

Progress in realizing the terms and conditions referred to herein will be reviewed periodically as mutually agreed and the memorandum may be amended at any time by mutual consent and in writing. Both parties reserve the right to terminate this memorandum by either party by giving six

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months written notice to the other. The implementation and/or continuance of programmes or projects established pursuant to this memorandum prior to the effective date of termination shall not be affected by the termination of this Memorandum.

#### **IV. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND CONFIDENTIALITY**

1. In respect of each project and programme of co-operation, the parties shall negotiate and mutually agree in writing on their respective rights to intellectual property and commercial exploitation of the same (including without limitation, trademarks and service marks, copyrights, patents, designs and confidential information pertaining thereto).
2. Neither party shall, at any time disclose to any third party any confidential information of the other party which is acquired in the course of activities under this Memorandum, a collaborative project or a programme, without the prior consent of the other party in writing.
3. The confidentiality obligations herein will not apply to information in the public domain; information in the possession of the receiving party prior to the disclosure of the information; information which is independently developed by the receiving party; information required to be released by law; and information which is rightfully received by the receiving party from third parties without any breach of confidentiality obligations.

#### **V. NON.BINDING NATURE OF MEMORANDUM**

Nothing in this Memorandum shall be construed as creating any contract, partnership, agency or other legal relationship between the parties. This Memorandum is only a non-binding statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

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## **VI. TERMINATION**


1. This memorandum shall come into force immediately upon its signature by the parties.
2. The validity of this Memorandum of Understanding is initially for a period of five years from the date of its execution and the same can be further extended on mutual agreement.
3. This Memorandum of Understanding can be terminated by either of the parties by giving advance notice of six months and without jeopardizing the coursework or registration of any of the students of either institution.

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
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

**(B) Promotion of:**

- i. Co – operation in the study and research of Law and related policy.
- ii. Innovation in reforming and reinvigorating Indian legal education.
- iii. Inter-jurisdictional continuing legal education ("CLE") opportunities as may arise.

**(C.) Other forms of cooperation which the two institutions may jointly arrange.**

2. Without prejudice to the generality of the above clause, the specific manner of cooperation between MAT LAW SCHOOL and PATNA LAW COLLEGE is as follows;

**(A) Student Non – Degree Exchange**

- i. Each law school will encourage its students to make use of the non – Degree exchange opportunity between the two school/College/University.

- i. Faculty at each law school may serve as joint supervisors for postgraduate research

- iii. Each school may specify the area to be taught, and / or may solicit nominations from the other. The final hiring decision will be made by the host school;
- iv. Compensation will continue to be provided by the home institution, unless otherwise decided by the law schools.
- v. Faculty may co-teach a course for a length of time shorter than one semester/trimester, as approved by the relevant internal and host institution administration.

**(D) Co-operation in the study and research of Law and related policy:**

Opportunities may be sought to host joint conferences, seminars, and working papers, as initiated by faculty in the law schools.

**(E) Innovation in reforming and reinvigorating Indian legal education**

Since MATS LAW SCHOOL and PATNA LAW COLLEGE represent recent, robust, and innovative entrants into Indian legal education, they should involve in an ongoing exchange of ideas and expertise towards the development of legal education in India, which may involve organizing joint conferences, public lectures and seminar between both the schools.

**(F) Continuing legal education ("CLE") opportunities as may arise**






