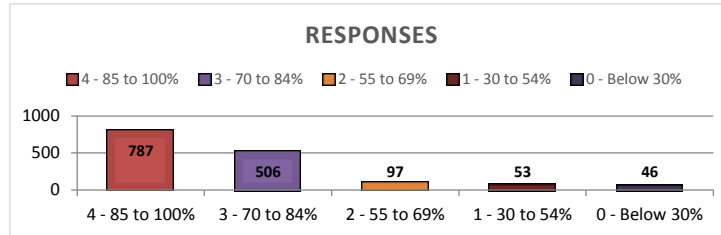

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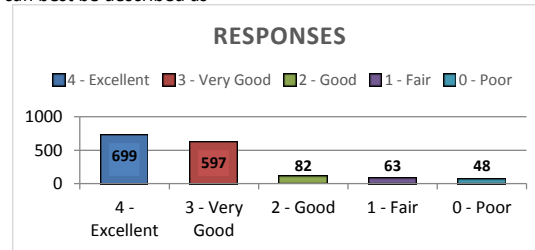

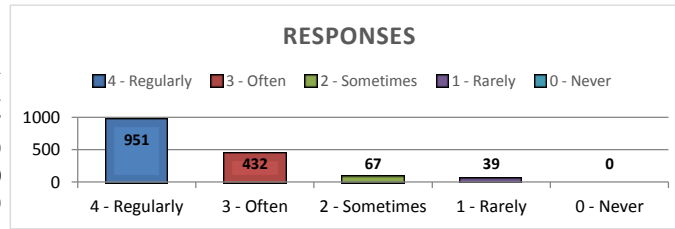
Q2. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

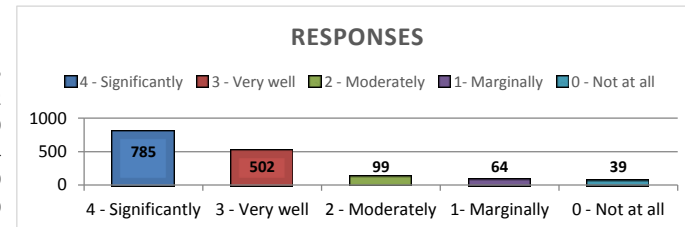
Q3. The institute take active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit etc. for students

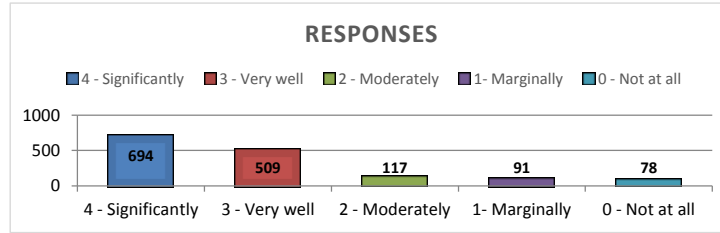
Q4. The teaching and mentoring process in the institute facilitates you in cognitive social and emotional growth

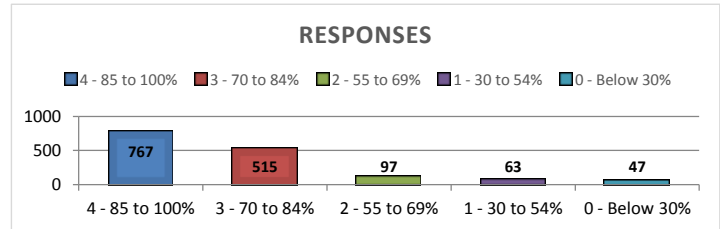
Q5. Is the curriculum for the courses designed keeping in mind the practical aspects

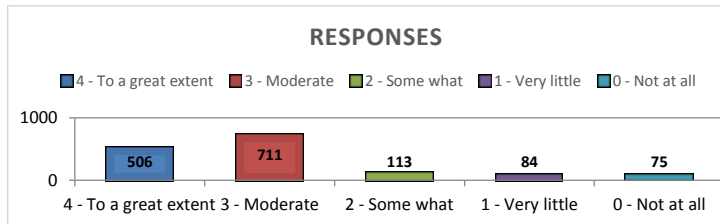
Q6. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia etc. while teaching

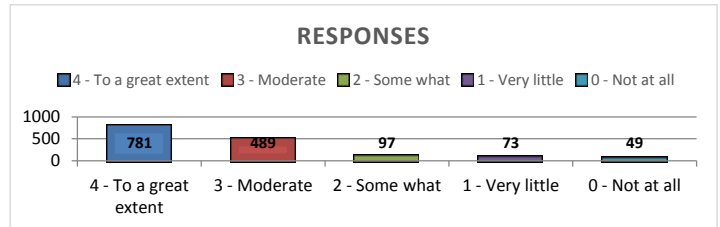

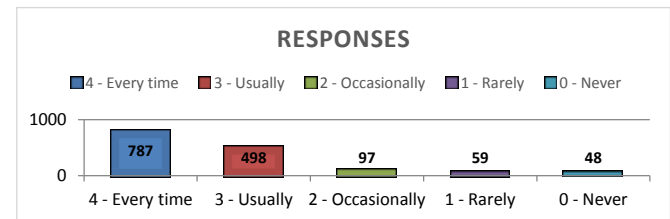
Q8. Efforts are made by the institute to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the outside world

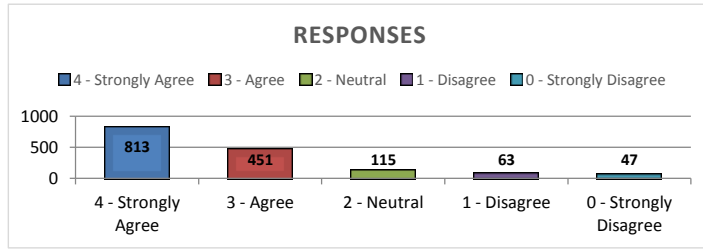
Q9. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them

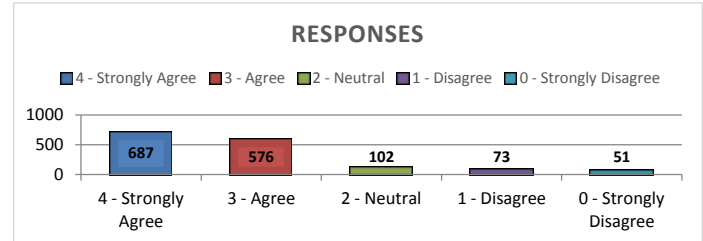
Q10. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities
