Description of Event/ Activity : One day Workshop on Copyright was organized on 07 May 2016 by CSE department, MATS University, Raipur. Chief (P&A), National Research Development Corporation on “Copyright”. In his lecture he said that Copyright refers to the legal right of the owner of intellectual property. In simpler terms, copyright is the right to copy. This means that the original creator of a product and anyone he gives authorization to are the only ones with the exclusive right to reproduce the work. Copyright law gives creators of original material, the exclusive right to further develop them for a given amount of time, at which point the copyrighted item becomes public domain. He also covered the topics: What is protected by ‘Copyright’? , How Long Does Copyright Last? What is copyrightable? What cannot be copyrighted? What are the laws of copyright? Last few minutes were given for Question and Answer session.
