
एमएसआईटी द्वारा शिक्षक दिवस का आयोजन ग्राम अमेठी में

School of Information Technology Celebrates Teachers Day at Village Akolikala Near Arang (C.G.)




एमएसआईटी विभाग द्वारा ग्राम गिरौद में शिक्षक दिवस समारोह


